N.P.G.A. RULES TO GOVERN. N.P.G.A SANCTIONED. ONLY ANIMALS WITH ORIGINAL REGISTRATION PAPERS OR REGISTRATION PAPERS WITH TRANSFERS LESS

THAN NINETY (90) DAYS WILL BE ALLOWED TO SHOW. WETHERS AND UNREGISTERABLE DOES DO NOT NEED REGISTRATION PAPERS TO BE SHOWN. PLEASE BRING ONLY HEALTHY ANIMALS.

N.P.G.A. RULES: (1) It is the ultimate responsibility of the exhibitor that the exhibitor's goat(s) is/are entered and shown in the correct age class and division. (Rule B3a). (2) Exhibitors shall not show any doe or buck in an N.P.G.A sanctioned show with the herd name(s) of the judge who is judging the show. This does not apply to wethers or unregistered classes or sanctioned 4-H/Youth shows. (Rule B3b).

Original Registration Papers Need To Be Present At The Show.

Entry Fees: \$6.00 per WCPGA Member. \$8.00 per entry Non- WCPGA Member. \$11.00 per entry if postmarked after October 16, 2014. NO REFUNDS. You may email entries as well to pygmymom@verizon.net

Master Champion entries: Please email ahead for numbers of animals participating. If you decide not to bring your PGCH; please let Pam know at least 3 days before.

Check-In: Limited check in on Friday night. Check-In 6:30 am. **Show starts 8:00am**
Second show will follow. Sunday show starts at 8:00am.

Pen Fees: \$6.00 each for the weekend. NO BEDDING WILL BE PROVIDED. Pens are limited. If you have your own pens please bring them. Pens will be assigned.

Please clean your pens and area before you leave.

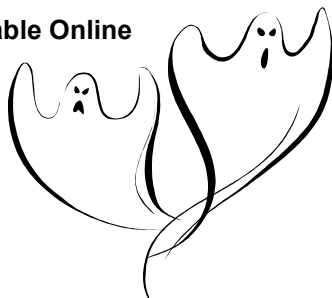
